

## WILDERNESS ARCHERY HUNT PERSONAL ITEMS LIST

Hunting License/Conservation Stamp and Archery License
Picture ID
Archery Equipment: Spend time practicing before your hunt. Be comfortable to 50 yards
Sleeping Bag: We like Hallo-Fill or down. Rated down to -10. We furnish cots and
foam pads
<b>Binocular's</b> : 8 x 42 or more powerful.
Hunting Knife
Hat: For protection and warmth. Color should be camo.
Alarm/Phone/Camera (with battery pack)
Head lamp and extra batteries
Camo Hunting Clothing
Socks: wicking
Toilet Kit: Include a Chap Stick, sunscreen, Tylenol or ibuprofen and medication.
Rain gear: Gortex is the best
Coat: One light jacket and one heavy coat, camo.
Sunglasses
Lighter
Liquor: We don't do any heavy drinking, but an evening drink goes well after a hard
day hunting.
<b>Boots:</b> 2 pair of waterproof hunting boots; wear one, pack one
Gloves: 2 pair waterproof
Camp Shoes: comfortable shoes to wear around camp.
Pants: Blue jeans or wool pants, camo.
Long Underwear: Two pair
Plastic Bag: Handy to have for dirty clothes.
2 Duffle Bags: 18"X 30" works best. We prefer two 35# dufflels
rather than one large duffel.
Towel and Wash Cloth
Small Canteen or Water Bottle
Face Paint/ Scent killer Cow call and cover scents if wanted; remember they are
a bear attractant.
Game Bags: cheesecloth style works well
Rear Spray Needs to be nurchased locally
